Also referred as decommissioning or archiving.

THE GOOD	<ul> <li>The passive migration strategy requires the least funds, time, unique expertise, and effort.</li> <li>Reduces expenditure on idle resources by retiring enables the organization to focus on areas that provide more business value and saves resources.</li> </ul>
THE BAD	<ul> <li>A careful analysis is required to ensure that retiring any component does not adversely impact other business processes.</li> <li>You must be aware of all the upstream dependencies of a workload before retiring them.</li> </ul>
THE UGLY	<ul> <li>Deciding if applications should be retired can often become complex and involves a level of risk. This can result in action being postponed, especially if subject matter experts (SMEs) have left an organization.</li> <li>Also, documentation about legacy systems can be sparse.</li> </ul>
